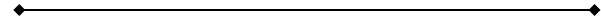

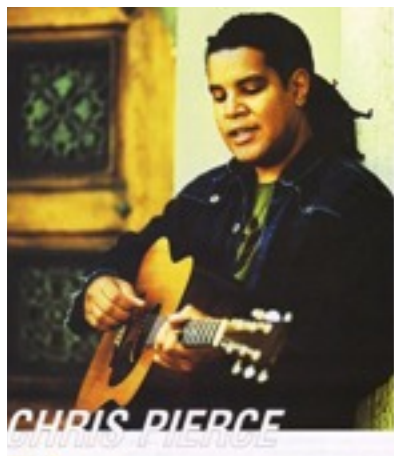
Chris Pierce Live in Concert

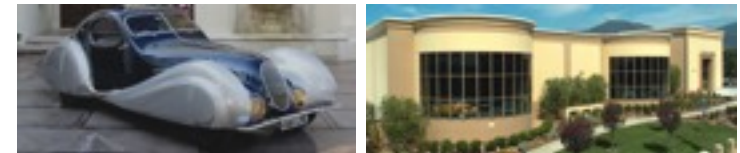
